



Tips of Tree Planting

When should we plant?



Rainy Season
Buganda, Teso and Western region
→ from March to April, September to November
Northern region, Achwa
→ from April to October



How shall we prepare before planting?

1 or 2 months before the planting, you are expected to cut, dry and burn the shrubs, and spray weeds.



How deep should the pit be?

Pit should be 1 foot (20 cm) deep and 1 foot wide on the average.



How do we plant?

Remove the polyethylene and make sure you cover the seedling properly with loam soil.
